#### Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Commission a declaration of results for the election [E2014/236]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 154D(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe.

Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the Australian Hotels Association-South Australian Branch must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
  - the name of the office vacated;
  - the date of the change of office holder; and
  - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
  - the name of the office now held;
  - the date of the change of office holder;
  - the name of the person now holding the office;
  - the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
  - the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. I have attached a template notification of changes which may assist you. If any change does not apply until a specific date, you don't need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

#### Arrangements for the conduct of an election (E2014/236)

I refer to the prescribed information dated 12 November 2014 which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission on 12 November 2014 for a scheduled election of the South Australian Branch of the Australian Hotels Association (AHA).

A copy of the decision in relation to the above matter is enclosed.

The Fair Work Commission is making arrangements, under subsections 189(3) of the *Fair Work* (*Registered Organisations*) Act 2009, with the Electoral Commissioner for the conduct of the subject election by a member of staff of the Australian Electoral Commission, who will contact you in the near future about the election.

During the process of checking requirements for this election, it came to my attention that rule 11 of the AHA National rulebook contains provisions that have been superseded. For example:

- sub-rule 11(aa)(A) provides for elections conducted subsequent to 2005; and
- sub-rule 11(aa)(B) provides for elections conducted in 2006, 2007 and 2008

Similarly, the Australian Electoral Commission also noted, in their post-election report for the AHA Queensland Branch election in E2013/140, that there is confusion - though not direct conflict - in National rules 11(a) and 11(aa)(D) in relation to which officers are to serve ex-officio as National Board Delegates.

In order to reduce potential confusion in the rulebook and to assist the process of future elections, it is recommended that the AHA make rule alterations under s.159 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* to delete provisions in rule 11 of the AHA National rulebook that no longer apply. It is recommended that you discuss this matter with the National Board in order to make the appropriate alterations.
