Dear Mr. Jubb,

In processing the Branch's recent election notification I noted that the manner of determining the number of Delegates to Branch Council each Sub-Branch is entitled to is deficient.

Rule 9(a)(ii) of the Tasmanian Branch rules provides that each Sub-Branch shall be represented on Branch Council by one Delegate for every twenty members of part thereof in excess of ten. No provision is made as to when that formula is to be applied.

I suggest, in order to accurately ascertain the number of representatives each Sub-Branch is entitled to on Branch Council, that an appropriate alteration be made to the Branch's rules providing the date the formula as provided in subrule 9(a)(ii) is to be applied.
