I am the Victorian Branch President of the Australian Hotels Association.

I am authorised to lodge the following prescribed information concerning forthcoming elections in the Victorian Branch of the Australian Hotels Association.

I confirm that the following information is being lodged under subsection 189 (1) of the RAO Schedule.

#### **National Board Elections**

Elections of Victorian Branch delegates is required as the terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the Australian Hotels Association National Rules (Rule 11).

In accordance with National Rule 11(a) as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2004 there was more than 1,900 hotels in Victoria, therefore in accordance with this rule Victoria is entitled to 7 representatives to the National Board. Furthermore in accordance with National Rule 11(a) the President and Senior Vice President of the Australian Hotels Association Victorian Branch shall be Ex Officio.

#### **In accordance with National Rule 11 (e)**

The electorate for collegiate electoral system is by and from the Branch Committee of Management (totalling 9 persons)

Nominations open: 18<sup>th</sup> March 2004

Nominations close: 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2004

In accordance with National Rule 11 (f) paragraph 2 "Nominations which are not completed as required by this Rule or not received at the registered office of the Branch on or before the first day of April shall be disregarded."
