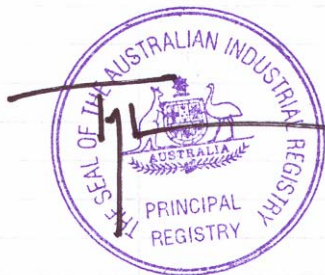

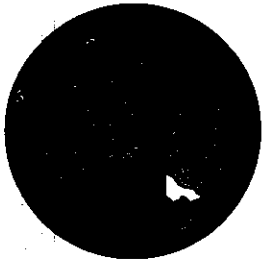
DECISION

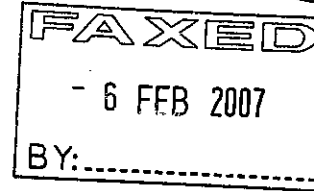
