Details required to be provided pursuant to RAO Schedule S. 189 (1) are attached.



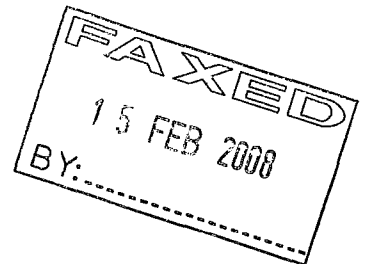

- (1) (a) The positions for which an election is required is the Victorian delegates to the Australian Hotels Association National Board;
- (b) The reason for the election is that the term of the office or position has expired or is due to expire in the normal course of events;
- (d) The electorate comprises members of the Australian Hotels Association (Victoria) branch Executive Committee;
- (e) Nominations are required to be lodged on or before 1 April 2008. The date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations will be called for or may be made is to be determined by the Australian Electoral Commission (The Returning Officer);
- (f) The role of voters is to be closed 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open, and
- (g) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is the direct voting system.
- (2) The above information is lodged under Section 189 (1) of the RAO Schedule.
