[2] In relation to the Councillors representing the <u>Residential (accommodation) Hotels Division</u>, I note that Victoria Branch rule 5 establishes a Division known as the <u>Residential Hotelkeepers'</u> <u>Division</u> and provides that the members of such Division shall be entitled to elect six members to Council.
