



The Chairman declared the meeting open at 10.00 am.

Mr Monaghan commented on the recent announcement by the Premier of the dropping of the Government's deregulation proposal, and congratulated Bradley Woods on a great job in overturning this proposed legislation

2.2 Divisional Boundaries and Rule Changes

Rule Changes

Following the proposal at the State Council Meeting on July 29th to amend the number of State Councillors and change the Divisional Boundaries, due to a technicality, the WAIRC has not granted the Application to alter the rules. The proposed changes to the number of State Councillors for this years elections, would not change.

A new application with the proposed rule changes would be prepared and resubmitted to the WAIRC.

It was resolved that State Council and Branch Committee of Management authorise the Executive Director to:

- review the rule changes put to the October 2003 AGM in light of the comments from the WAIRC and taking into account the further technical changes discussed with either the WAIRC or AIRC; and
- prepare a series of rule changes for consideration at the next State Council meeting for submission to the next Annual General Meeting for approval.

Divisional Boundaries

Mr Woods overviewed the proposed changes to the Divisional Boundaries which were agreed at the State Council Meeting on July 29th, 2003. It had been agreed that the divisional boundaries would mirror the new WATC zones, with the Perth region being split into two zones, totalling 6 divisions in all.

These new divisions would come into effect at the elections to be held next month.

It was resolved that the Divisional Boundaries for the Australian Hotels Association, WA Branch and the Western Australian Hotels and Hospitality Association (Union of Employers):

- i. divide the state of Western Australia into six zones;
- ii. are based on the five zones announced by the Western Australian Tourism Commission, with the Perth Metropolitan area having two zones;
- iii. are named, for the country areas accordingly –
 - Central Division (based on yellow zone)
 - South West Division (based on Green zone)
 - North West Division (based on Red zone) and
 - Coastal Division (based on Blue zone)

- iv. are named, for the Metropolitan areas
Perth Metropolitan North Division and
Perth Metropolitan South Division

MEMORANDUM

RE: CONSEQUENTIAL MATTERS RELATING TO DIVISIONAL BORDERS

BACKGROUND

The Rules [Attachment 1] authorise Branch Committee of Management / State Council [BCM/SC] to divide the state of Western Australia into zones and from time to time vary the boundaries of any zone.

In July 2003 to address longstanding concerns about the size of the BCM/SC structures and current level of participation, the BCM/SC approved a motion [Attachment 2] :

- Reducing the BCM/ SC from 12 to 6 and territory Divisions from 12 to 6; and
- Use of the WA Tourism Commission Authority [WATC] zones for this purpose.

Increased communication through modern technology allowed a smaller and more dynamic arrangement. Further steps include contemplation of merging State Council and Executive.

DISCUSSION

The area within each WATC zone offers uniform electorates. The metropolitan area would be more manageable if sub-divided into two zones. This approach provides the 6 separate Territorial Divisions BCM/SC asked for. The WATC zones are distinguished through colours, for our purposes different names will be used to avoid confusion.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Divisional boundaries for the Australian Hotels Association, WA Branch, and the Western Australian Hotels and Hospitality Association (Union of Employers):

- i. Divide the state of Western Australia into six zones,
- ii. Are based on the five zones announced by the Western Australian Tourism Commission (*see Attachment 3*), with the Perth Metropolitan area having two zones;
- iii. Are named, for the Country areas (*see Attachment 4*), accordingly:

- Central Division (based on Yellow Zone).
 - South West Division (based on Green Zone);
 - North West Division (based on Red Zone); and
 - Coastal Division (based on Blue Zone).
- iv. Are named, for the Metropolitan Areas (see *Attachment 5*), accordingly:
- Perth Metropolitan North Division (based on Orange Zone North of River),
and
 - Perth Metropolitan South Division (based on Orange Zone South of River)
- v. Take affect from the next subsequent elections being the 2004 elections.

Attachment 2 – Extract of Minutes State Council WAHHA and AHA 29th July 2003

Divisional Borders

Mr David Strom had raised an issue at the last Executive Meeting with regards to Divisional Presidents nominations and level of attendance at Divisional meetings.

The Executive agreed that the ED would undertake a review of the boundaries and present to State Council a model which included a substantially reduced number of Divisional Presidents and ordinary State Council members

Discussion took place with regards to concerns about the size of State Council and the participation at State Council Meetings

In particular, concerns were raised about:

- Lack of nominations for Divisional President,
- Poor attendance at State Council meetings, and
- Increased communication between members from the office via email, fax and mail meant that there was less and less attendance at Divisional meetings.

Mr Woods suggested to State Council that a recommendation would be to look at redistributing divisional boundaries in line with the new WATC Tourism zones.

Mr Ramage commented that this overview of State Council and Division Boundaries was long overdue and that State Council needed to become smaller and more dynamic. It was suggested that at some time in the future the SC and Executive could merge into one and that this was a desirable possibility to create better efficiencies.

A motion was moved proposing that State Council be reduced from 12 to 6, and that the territory Divisions be reduced from 12 to six based on the Western Australian Tourism commission Authority zones with two representatives from the metropolitan area, and that elections be changed from annually to every two years.

Mr Woods would prepare an Executive Summary of a proposal for State Council's approval and fax back to the next Executive Meeting to be held on August 19th and this to be sent to State Council for ratification.

The different legal entities each require different procedures and time of rule changes.

Some amendments would be required to be executed in time for the Annual General Meeting and others to be tabled at the October State Council meeting.

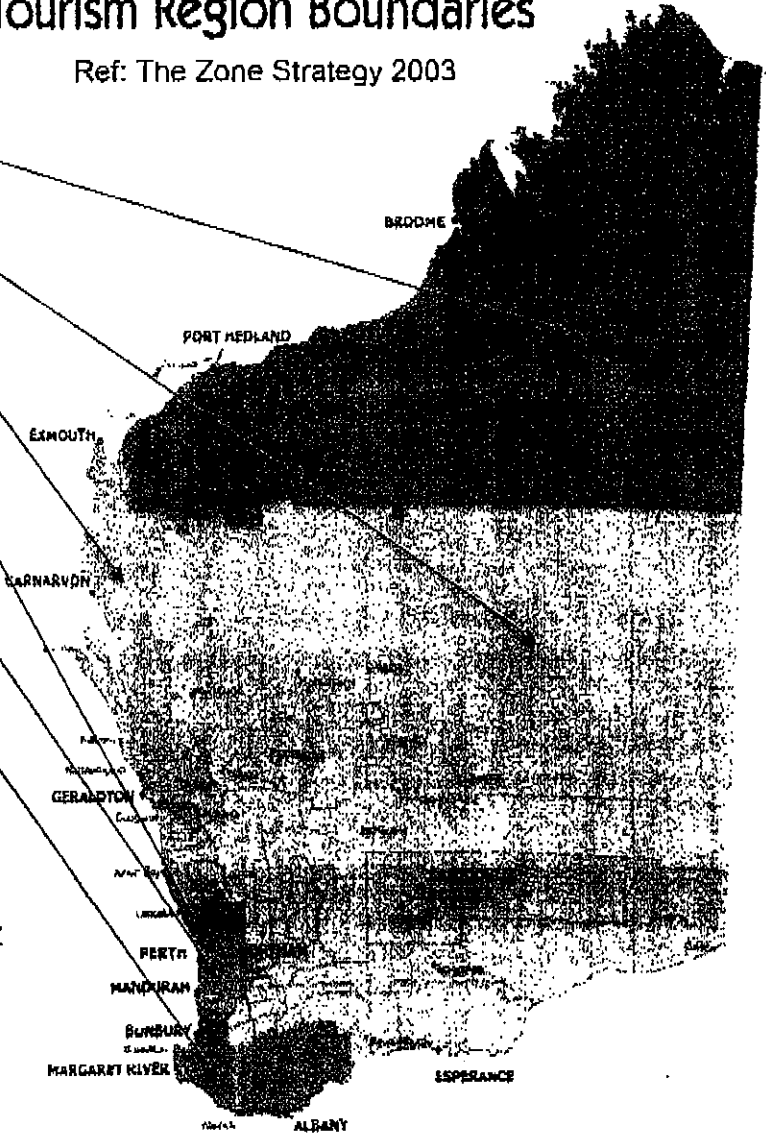


