One (1) President for the following Non-Territorial Division:

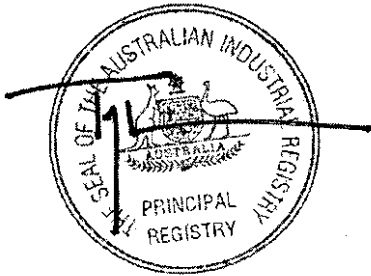

**NOTIFICATION OF ELECTIONS PURSUANT OF SECTION 189 AND

In accordance with the Workplace Relations Act and Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Amendment (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Consequential Provisions) Act 2002, I enclose, as Attachment 1, the prescribed information and statement of Mr Neil Randall, President of the Australian Hotels Association Western Australian Branch.

PART A

Under Section 11 (aa) B of the National Rules of the Australian Hotels Association, the Western Australian Branch is permitted 2 representatives on the National Board. Of these 2 members, the President shall be ex officio with the other being elected by the Branch Committee of Management.

- 1 representative to the Australian Hotels Association National Accommodation Board

Rule 11 (e) requires that the Returning Officer shall call for nominations of representatives to the National Board at least 14 days prior to 1 April 2006.

- One representative from each of the Territorial Divisions (6 in total)
 - Perth Metropolitan North Division
 - Perth Metropolitan South Division

- Accommodation Division


