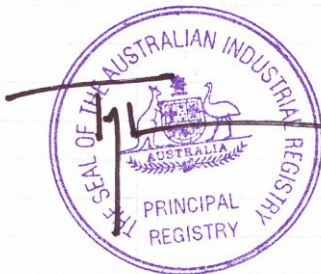
DECISION
