#### NOTIFICATION OF ELECTIONS OF AUSTRALIAN HOTELS ASSOCIATION WA BRANCH - PURSUANT TO SECTION 189 -REGISTRATION AND ACCOUNTABILITY OF ORGANISATIONS OF THE FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) ACT 2009-

In accordance with the Schedule 1 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 I enclose, as Attachment 1, the prescribed information and statement of Mr Neil Randall, President of the Australian Hotels Association Western Australian Branch.

#### PART A

Under Section 11 (aa) C of the National Rules of the Australian Hotels Association, the Western Australian Branch is permitted three (3) representatives on the National Board. Of these three (3) members, the President shall be ex officio with the other two (2) members being elected by the Branch Committee of Management.

Therefore it is requested that the following be elected by the Branch Committee of Management:

o 2 representatives to the Australian Hotels Association National Board

Under Section 42 (c) of the National Rules of the Australian Hotels Association, the Western Australian Branch is permitted one (1) representative on the National Accommodation Board. This representative shall be elected by members of the Western Australian Accommodation Division.

Therefore, it is requested that the following be elected by the Western Australian Accommodation Division:

 1 representative to the Australian Hotels Association National Accommodation Board

Rule 11(e) requires that the Returning Officer shall call for nominations of representatives to the National Board at least 14 days prior to 1 April 2012.
