I refer to correspondence received from the Western Australian Branch of the Australian Hotels Association (AHA-WA) dated 10 February 2014, which was signed by Mr Woods and which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission (FWC) on 11 February 2014 in response to our request for further prescribed information in respect of the conduct of a scheduled election for offices of the AHA-WA.

In relation to the advice regarding the office of President (Accommodation Hotels), I note that this office is included in Part B of your prescribed information for the Branch Committee of Management election. However the Executive offices are the subject to a second collegiate election at the June meeting of the Branch Committee of Management and as such should also be reflected in Part C of your PI (in accordance with rule (a)(v) of the AHA-WA rulebook). This is regardless of the 'automatic' nature of the election of the above office to the Executive.

In relation to the advice regarding the office of President (Licensed Restaurant Division), I note that rule 13(a)(vii) and 10B of the AHA-WA rulebook provides for this office and division. Under section 189(3)(b) of the Fair Work Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (RO Act) the General Manager must be satisfied that an election is required to be held under the rules of the organisation or branch. Accordingly, as this office is currently included in the AHA-WA rulebook, it must be included in the prescribed information in order for the General Manager or her Delegate to issue a decision. If as you advise in your letter that the Licensed Restaurant Division no longer exists, and the AHA-WA does not wish to arrange for an election of this office in future, then the AHA-WA will need to lodge an application for an alteration of its rules pursuant to section 159 of the RO Act to remove this office and division from its rulebook.


