Dear Ms Han,

I refer to the information lodged on 26 March, which I attach for convenient reference. The letter of Mr Christiansen omitted a declaration that is specifically required by subsection 233(1)(b).

Subsection 233(1)(b) requires the secretary to certify that the lodged "copy of the records required to be kept under paragraphs 230(1)(b), (c) and (d) is a correct statement of the information contained in those records".

The return includes the information kept under the aforementioned paragraphs but not this formal verification statement. I have reviewed the previous returns from the organisation and also the correspondence from the Registry/FWA, and this omission does not appear to have ever been brought to the organisation's attention.

The information is otherwise satisfactory but, given that the declaration forms part of the public documentation on record, and in the interests of complete compliance, I would ask that a brief supplementary declaration be signed by Mr Christiansen that explicitly states "the copy of the records kept under paragraphs 230(1)(b), (c) and (d) that was lodged with FWC on 26 March 2013 is a correct statement of the information contained in those records". Errors and inadvertent omissions are usually avoided if the wording of the Act is closely followed.

New Branches	A record of the name of each branch that commenced operation in the previous 12 months [s.230(1)(d) and r.147(b)]
Old Branches	A record of the name of each branch that ceased operation in the previous 12 months [s.230(1)(d) and r.147(c)]
Addresses of Organisation and Branches	A record of the address of the office of the organisation and the address of the office of each branch [s.230(1)(d) and r.147(d)]
Elections in Organisation and Branches	A record of each election that must, under the rules of the organisation, be held during the year commencing 1 January of the year in which the return is lodged, for any offices in the organisation and branches of the organisation . Obligation to notify of changes within 35 days

If there are any changes during the year to the list of offices, list of officeholders, list of branches (where relevant) and the address of the organisation and/or its branches an organisation must, within 35 days of the change, lodge with The Commission, a notification of such changes certified by declaration signed by the secretary or other prescribed officer of the organisation to be a correct statement of the changes made [RO Act s.233(2) and RO Regulations r.151 refer].
