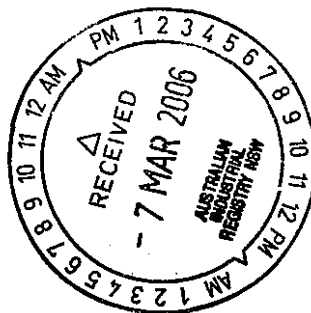

Rules difficult to apply/interpret: Rules 33(B)(iii) and 33(B)(v).

- 33(B)(iii) requires the RO to advertise for nominations before the open of nominations (possibly causing nominations to be received prior to nominations opening);

Similarly, 33(B)(v) may cause problems due to the instruction to send out ballots 14 days before the ballots open (causing ballot papers to be received prior to ballots opening).
