#### Cut off date for roll:

#### Note:

Make sure the declaration is adjusted as appropriate to reflect the facts.

The Notice and Statement are required to be ladged at least 2 months before the first day of naminations as set out in the rules of the organisation – the General Manager of the Fair Work Commission may allow for a later day (see subsection 189(2) and regulations).

The requirement to lodge election information under s. 189(2) is a civil penalty provision (see s. 305).

#### Courtesy Letter - Election for offices [E2015/88]

A perusal of the rules of The Australian Institute of Marine and Power Engineers discloses that an election for offices within the branch is due to commence shortly. It appears from information gathered from the rules and from our records that nominations for the election of Treasurer and Ordinary Members of Federal Council are due to open in the month of June this year. This is based on the AEC declaring the last election for these offices in September 2013.

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the obligation to lodge information about the election (known as the 'prescribed information') pursuant to sections 189(1) and (2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the 'Act') within the next month. This is so because the prescribed information must be lodged with the Fair Work Commission two months before nomination open for the election.

If you have a different interpretation for the commencement of the election under your rules, please let me know, otherwise, the prescribed information should contain details of the election as required by regulation 138(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* (the 'Regulations'), and should include any subsequent elections such as an election for offices under the collegiate electoral system, if that is relevant. The prescribed information should be emailed to <a href="mailto:orgs@fwc.gov.au">orgs@fwc.gov.au</a>. If your branch believes that it will be unable to comply with the prescribed day as set out in the Regulations, it will need to apply to the General Manager for a later date. Such request will need to set out in detail the reason why your branch is unable to comply with the requirement. While the General Manager will consider such an application, there is no assurance that consent to a later day will be allowed.

It should be noted Section 189(2) is a civil penalty provision. Failure to comply may result in legal proceedings being issued with the possibility of a pecuniary penalty being imposed upon an officer and/or your branch.
