STATUTORY DECLARATION


I, Martin Byrne of 1 Murray Street Lidcombe in the State of New South Wales do solemnly and sincerely declare:

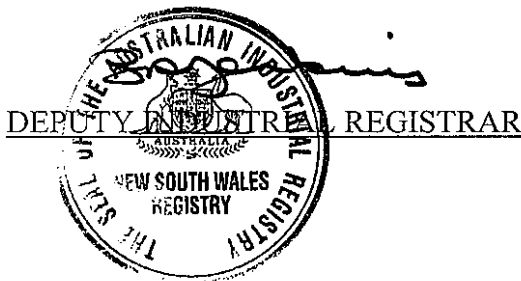
