Reg 138 (1) (a) Name of Positions:

- A Branch President (1)
- B Branch Treasurer (1)
- C Ordinary Member of Federal Council (2)

Reg 138 (1) (b) Reason for Elections:

The reason for the Election of the officers and positions marked **A**, **B** and **C** above is that the term of office all expired on 22nd September 2010.

Reg 138 (1) (c) Number of positions:

The number of Ordinary Members of Federal Council to be elected is two (2).

Reg 138 (1) (d) The Electorate:

The electorate is the whole of the branch.

Reg 138 (1) (e) Nominations Open:

The nominations should open at least one month before the date fixed for the election (Rule 33 B (iii)).

Reg 138 (1) (e) Nominations Close:

Closing of nominations should be as arranged between the Branch Secretary and the Returning Officer ((Rule 33 B (iii)).

Reg 138 (1) (f) Cut off Date for roll:

The Rules of the AIMPE are silent as to cut off date.

Reg 138 (1) (g) Method of Election:

The direct voting system is the method to be used for these ballots. The Rules of the AIMPE specify that financial members shall elect the Branch officials (Rule 33 B (i)).
