#### Scheduled Election E2013/102

I refer to the above election for your organisation.

Section 197(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Fair Work Commission and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. A copy of the report in relation to this election is attached.

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 9 January 2013 the Sydney Branch of The Australian Institute of Marine and Power Engineers ('the organisation') lodged with the Fair Work Commission the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

### **Sydney Branch**

Branch President	(1)
Branch Treasurer	(1)
Branch Secretary	(1)
Ordinary Member of Federal Council	(2)

- The prescribed information in respect of the Branch Secretary was lodged later than the prescribed day. The nominal expiry date of the previous term of office was 22 September 2012, being the date four years after its commencement following the previous election in E2008/181. The organisation's rulebook does not specify a fixed date for the opening of nominations, from which a fixed prescribed day can be calculated, but provides that the opening of nominations will be determined by a Returning Officer. However, in the normal course of events prescribed information should have been lodged a sufficient amount of time in advance of the expiry of the previous term that the conduct of the election could have commenced within a reasonable time. The request for the election of a Branch Secretary is therefore overdue by several months.
- [3] I consider that the period by which the previous term has been extended is not unreasonably long, considering that the delay will result in a synchronisation of the elections for all the Sydney Branch offices that are now required to be filled. In his email dated 9 January 2013 the Assistant Federal Secretary sought an extension of time for lodgement and, taking into account all relevant considerations, I allow, pursuant to subsection 189(2) of the Act, a later day for lodgement of the prescribed information up to the date of actual lodgement.

[4] I am satisfied that an election for the offices referred to in paragraph [1] above is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

## Reg 138 (1) (b) Reason for Elections:

The reason for the Election of the officers and positions marked A, B and D above is that the term of each office will expire on  $7^{th}$  March 2013.

The reason for the Election of the officer and position marked C above is that the term of office expired on  $22^{nd}$  September 2012.

## Reg 138 (1) (c) Number of positions:

The number of Ordinary Members of Federal Council to be elected is two (2).

## Reg 138 (1) (d) The Electorate:

The electorate is the whole of the branch.

## Reg 138 (1) (e) Nominations Open:

The nominations should open at least one month before the date fixed for the election (Rule 33 B (iii)).

## Reg 138 (1) (e) Nominations Close:

Closing of nominations should be as arranged between the Branch Secretary and the Returning Officer ((Rule 33 B (iii)).

## Reg 138 (1) (f) Cut off Date for roll:

The Rules of the AIMPE are silent as to cut off date.

## Reg 138 (1) (g) Method of Election:

The direct voting system is the method to be used for these ballots. The Rules of the AIMPE specify that financial members shall elect the Branch officials (Rule 33 B (i)).
