

RE: STATEMENT CONCERNING RECORD OF ELECTIONS

Under Sub Section 268 (1) (d) of the Workplace relations Act 1996 I submit that elections are held every four years, with the next elections due prior to the 30th day of June, 2010.

The vacancies for the offices of Federal President, Senior Vice President, Vice President, Federal Secretary, Assistant Federal Secretary, two Trustees and thirteen Councillor positions will be filled in accordance with rule 21 (1) of the Australian Licenced Aircraft Engineers Association constitution and rules, which is as follows:
