Thank you for your email of 20 October 2005 informing the Industrial Registry of the relocation of your Western Area Office.

The information has been noted, however, for the union to comply with its reporting requirements as set out by section 233 of Schedule 1B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (the RAO Schedule) and regulation 151 of the RAO Regulations, an organisation is required (in this case the AMOU) to lodge in the Registry, within 35 days of the change occurring, a declaration signed by the secretary or another officer of the union outlining the change.
