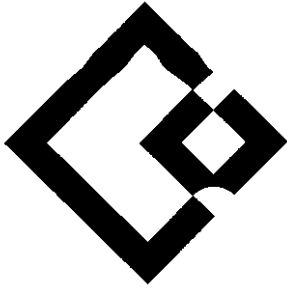

Re: Section 214 and Regulation 61 – Union Elections

Pursuant to Section 214 and Regulation 61 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, I advise that elections for the following offices within the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (ASU) are due to be held in 2003.

National President (1)
National Vice-President (1)
National Executive President (1)
National Secretary (1)
Assistant National Secretaries (2)

The Rules provide that nominations open on the Wednesday following the expiration of 28 days after the completion and declaration of all Branch elections for the offices of Branch National Executive Representatives, or the first Wednesday in July, whichever is the earlier.

The reason for the elections are either that the term of office has expired or that new offices have been created.

In all cases the electorate is the National Executive. The voting system to be employed is a direct voting system, with the exception of the election for Assistant National Secretaries which is by proportional representation using preferential voting.
