NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 20 MAY 2003.

#### 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards, other mandatory professional reporting requirements and the Australian Workplace Relations Act, 1996. The financial report has also been prepared on the basis of historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the economic entity in the preparation of the financial report.

a] No provision for Income Tax is necessary as the Union is exempt from Income Tax under Section 50 - 15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act.

#### 2. EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO BALANCE DATE

The Commonwealth Industrial Registrar has certified that on 21 May 2003 the MEU New South Wales Branch amalgamated with the New South Wales Clerical and Administrative Branch and henceforth the NSW Local Government, Clerical, Administrative, Energy, Airlines & Utilities Branch is duly registered as a branch of the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union under the provisions of the Workplace Relations Act 1996. The branch will trade as the United Services Branch.

#### 3. INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

### 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report has been prepared and presented in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards, other mandatory professional reporting requirements, the Workplace Relations Act, 1996 and the New South Wales Industrial Relations Act, 1996. The financial report has also been prepared on the basis of historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the union in the preparation of the financial report.

### (a) Depreciation

Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on the straight line basis in order to write the assets off over their useful lives to the Union

### (b) Employee Entitlements

Provision for employee benefits in the form of Accrued Annual Leave and Accrued Long Service Leave has been made for the estimated accrued entitlements of all employees on the basis of their terms of employment.

In the case of Long Service Leave, the accrual has been measured by reference to periods of service and current salary rates as it is considered that this results in an amount not materially different to that achieved by discounting estimated future cash flows.

### (c) Contributions

Contributions are accounted for on a cash receipts basis.

### (d) Investments

Investments, other than those in wholesale funds, are shown at cost. Investments in wholesale funds are shown at market value at the balance date. Movements in market values are included in investment income.

### (e) Income Tax

No provision for Income Tax is necessary as the Union is exempt from Income Tax under Section 50 - 15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act.
