NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report has been prepared and presented in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards, other mandatory professional reporting requirements and the Workplace Relations Act, 1996. The financial report has also been prepared on the basis of historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Branch in the preparation of the financial report.

- (a) Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on the straight line basis in order to write the assets off over their useful lives to the Branch.
- (b) The liability shown as 'United Services Union Provisions' is payable to the New South Wales Local Government, Clerical, Administrative, Energy, Airlines & Utilities Union for the entitlements of former employees of the NSW Clerical and Administrative Branch.
- (c) Contributions are accounted for on a cash receipts basis.
- (d) Investments, other than those in wholesale funds, are shown at cost. Investments in wholesale funds are shown at market value at the balance date. Movements in market values are included in investment income.
- (e) No provision for Income Tax is necessary as the Branch is exempt from Income Tax under Section 50 15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act.

2. INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

- (a) In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274 which read as follows:-
 - (i) A member of an organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.
 - (ii) An organisation shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a member of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.
 - (iii) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

3. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE BRANCH

The Commonwealth Industrial Registrar has certified that on 21 May 2003 the New South Wales Clerical and Administrative Branch amalgamated with the MEU New South Wales Branch and henceforth the NSW Local Government, Clerical, Administrative, Energy, Airlines, and Utilities Branch is duly registered as a branch of the Australian Municipal, Administrative Clerical and Services Union under the provisions of the Workplace Relations Act 1996. The branch will trade as the United Services Branch.

INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT

To the members of the Australian Services Union - NSW Local Government, Clerical, Administrative, Energy, Airlines & Utilities Branch.

SCOPE

We have audited the financial report of the Branch for the period from 21 May 2003 to 30 June 2003 as set out on pages 1 to 10. The Branch's Committee of Management and Accounting Officer are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial report and the information it contains. We have conducted an independent audit of the financial report in order to express an opinion on it to the members of the Branch.
