Schedule 1 – Registration and Accountability of Organisations Chapter 7, Part 2

I refer to my letter to the Industrial Registrar dated 14 December 2006 in which I advised the need for elections to be held for offices that will become vacant this year.

I wish to clarify that that my reference to various Sub-Branch Councillors, as set out below, mis-described the names of the positions.

Senior Officers' Sub-Branch Councillor
Northern Sub-Branch Councillor
Central Sub-Branch Councillor: 2 positions
Southern Sub-Branch Councillor: 2 positions

The vacancies on the ASU Tax Branch Council that are filled from the various sub-branches should have been described as Branch Councillor positions, not Sub-Branch Councillor positions.

I have set out the correct descriptions and numbers of vacancies below.

Senior Officers' Branch Councillor: 1 position
Northern Branch Councillor: 1 position
Central Branch Councillor: 2 positions
Southern Branch Councillor: 2 positions

My description of the electorate for each of these Branch Councillor positions from each of the sub-branches in my letter of 14 December is correct, except that again, each of the

vacant positions should be described as Branch Councillor, e.g. Senior Officers' Branch Councillor.

I also wish to confirm and certify that as at 31 December 2006, the Senior Officers' Sub-Branch had between 40 and 200 members, the Northern Sub-Branch had between 40 and 200 members, the Central Sub-Branch had between 201 and 500 members, the Southern Sub-Branch had between 201 and 500 members.

The ASU Rules provide that nominations shall open on the first Wednesday in March and shall close 21 days after they are called.

The reasons for the elections are that the term of office has expired or that new offices have been created.

In the case of the following positions, the electorate is the whole of the financial membership of the Branch. The voting system to be employed is a direct voting system.

Branch President, Deputy Branch President, Branch Secretary, Assistant Branch Secretary, Branch Treasurer, National Executive Representative: 2 positions, National Conference Delegates: 2 positions, The Alternate National Executive Representative, First Alternate National Conference Delegate, Second Alternate National Conference Delegate.

In the case of the **Senior Officers' Sub-Branch Councillor**, the electorate is those financial members of the Branch who are classified to the Executive Level 1, Executive Level 2 or Senior Executive Service across Australia.

In the case of the **Northern Sub-Branch Councillor**, the electorate is those financial members of the Branch employed in the Queensland Region, excluding those classified to the Executive Level 1, Executive Level 2 or Senior Executive Service.

In the case of the two **Central Sub-Branch Councillor positions**, the electorate is those financial members of the Branch employed in the N.S.W. and A.C.T. Regions, excluding those classified to the Executive Level 1, Executive Level 2 or Senior Executive Service.

In the case of the two **Southern Sub-Branch Councillor positions**, the electorate is those financial members of the Branch employed in the Victorian, Tasmanian, South Australian and West Australian Regions, excluding those classified to the Executive Level 1, Executive Level 2 or Senior Executive Service.
