If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

Re: Section 189 and Regulation 138 of the Fair Work Act

Pursuant to Section 189 and Regulation 138 of the Fair Work Act 2009 (Registered Organisations) I advise that elections for the following offices within the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (ASU) Victorian Private Sector Branch are due to be held in 2011.

A. Branch Officers and Branch Executive Members (National Rule 16, Branch Rule 4)

- Branch President
- Branch Vice President (Women)
- Branch Secretary
- Assistant Branch Secretary
- Six (6) Branch Executive Members made up of three (3) Branch Executive Members and three (3) Branch Executive Members (Women)

B. Branch Conference (Branch Rule 8)

- Six (6) members nominated and elected by and from the financial members allocated to the Airlines Industry Division three (3) of whom must be women.
- Ten (10) members nominated and elected by and from the financial members allocated to the Private Sector Industry Division five (5) of whom must be women.

C. National Executive Representatives (Branch Rule 9)

There are two (2) Branch National Executive Representatives. The First National Executive Representative shall be the Branch Secretary. The Second National Executive Representative shall be the Assistant Branch Secretary.

An Alternate National Executive Representative is also to be elected (Branch Rule 10)

D. National Conference Delegates (Branch Rule 11 & National Rule 7)

Whilst the number of National Conference Delegates to be elected is calculated in accordance with National Rule 7, the positions of Branch Secretary and Assistant Branch Secretary are deducted from this number.

So that in addition to the Branch Secretary and the Assistant Branch Secretary a total of seven (7) National Conference delegates are to be elected.

E. Alternate National Conference Delegate (Branch Rule 12)

There shall be a First, Second and Third Alternative National Conference Delegate

The ASU Rules provide that nominations shall open on the first Wednesday in March and shall close 21 days after they are called. For the scheduling of nominations we believe that the first Wednesday in March 2011 is the 2nd March.

The reasons for the elections are that the term of office has expired.

With the exception of Branch Conference Delegates elected by and from the Airlines Division and Private Sector Division (see Branch Rule 8) the electorate is the whole of the financial membership of the Branch. The voting system to be employed is a direct voting system.
