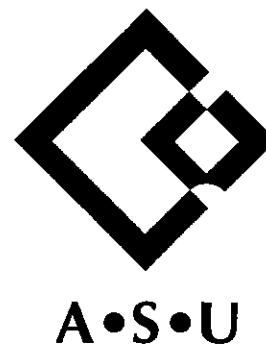

On the 11th December 2006 I wrote to you for the purpose of notifying that the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (ASU) Western Australian Branch elections are due to be held in 2007.

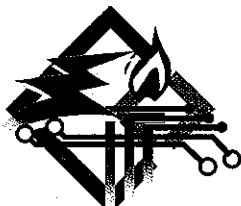

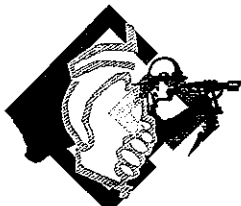

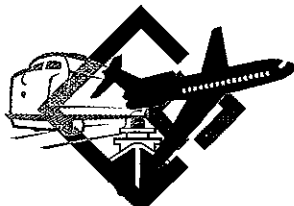

I am now able to confirm that the Western Australian Branch is entitled to a total of seven (7) National Conference Delegates, based on 5,148 Adult Member Equivalent's at 31st December 2006. Therefore we must call nominations for four (4) National Conference Delegates (WA Branch) in addition to the three (3) positions tied in accordance with the rules to the offices of Branch President, Branch Secretary and Assistant Branch Secretary.

Proportional Representation

Division Five, Western Australian Branch Rule 19 – “Proportional Representation” requires that women shall be represented among Branch Executive Council members in accordance with the formula set out in sub-rule 19(a).

Sub-rule 19(b) requires the Branch Secretary to provide to the Returning Officer a certificate showing the percentage of women financial members in the WA Branch. I am now able to certify that the Western Australian Branch membership as at 31st December 2006 requires that a minimum of four (4) Branch Executive Council members shall be women. This certification is based on the following data:

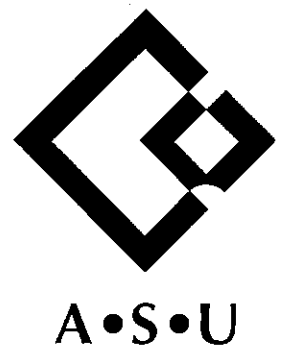
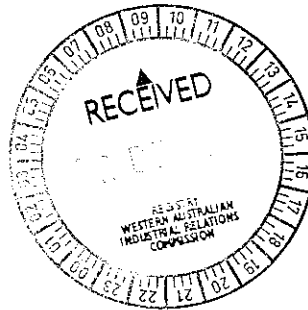

**RE: Schedule 1 – Registration and Accountability of Organisations (RAO)
Chapter 7 Part 2 – Conduct of Union Elections**

Pursuant to Section 189 and Regulation 138 of the RAO of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, I advise that elections for the following offices within the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (ASU) Western Australian Branch are due to be held in 2007.

The ASU Rules provide that nominations shall open on the first Wednesday in March 2007 and shall close 21 days after they are called.

The reasons for the elections are either that the term of office has expired or that new offices have been created.

The voting system to be employed is a direct voting system, and unless otherwise stated the electorate is the whole of the financial membership of the Western Australian Branch.

For the purpose of the elections, the roll of voters shall close on the fifteenth day of the month immediately preceding the date of calling nominations, and only members shown as financial in the records of the Western Australian Branch on that date shall be eligible to vote in the election.

Division Five, Western Australian Branch Rule 8 – “Voting on Branch Executive Council” provides that the number of Branch Executive Councillors to be elected to represent each of those Divisions shall be determined by the lowest number of financial members allocated to each Division as at the last day of October, November or December in the preceding year.

The following data provides the lowest number of financial members allocated to each Division as at the last day of October and November 2006:

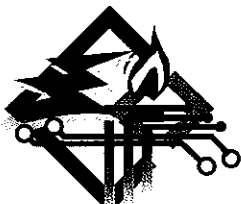

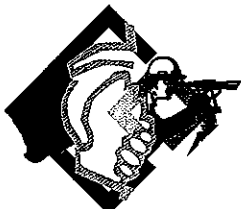

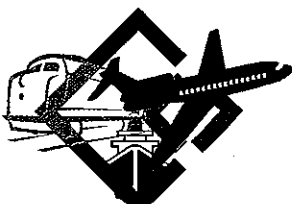
