Section 197(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the General Manager and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. Section 198 and the regulations also require an organisation to make the post election report and the organisation's response to the report (if applicable) available to members.

Further, Regulation 141(4) of the Fair Work Regulations 2009 requires an organisation or branch to publish a notice on its web site advising members that a copy of the post election report is available upon request. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

Pursuant to Section 182 and Regulation 138 (1) Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009, I advise that elections of the following officers within the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (ASU) Western Australian Branch are due to be held in 2011.

The ASU Rules provide that nominations shall open on the first Wednesday in March 2011 and shall close 21 days after they are called.

The reason for the election is that the current term of office will expire in June 2011.

The voting system to be employed is a direct voting system, and unless otherwise stated the electorate is the whole of the financial membership of the Western Australian Branch.

For the purpose of the elections, the roll of voters shall close on the fifteenth day of the month immediately preceding the date of calling nominations, and only members shown as financial in the records of the Western Australian Branch on that date shall be eligible to vote in the election.

Division Five, Western Australian Branch Rule 8 – “Voting on Branch Executive Council” provides that the number of Branch Executive Councillors to be elected to represent each of those Divisions shall be determined by the lowest number of financial members allocated to each Division as at the last day of October, November or December in the preceding year.

The following data provides the lowest number of financial members allocated to each Division as at the last day of October, November and December 2010:

Administrative, Clerical & Customer Services Division	524 financial members
ASU Municipal Employees Division	600 financial members
Energy / Information Technology Division	1,205 financial members
Local Government Division	1,749 financial members
Social and Community Services Division	753 financial members
Transport Division	591 financial members

BRANCH EXECUTIVE COUNCIL (all four year terms)

- One (1) Branch Executive Councillor (Administrative, Clerical & Customer Services) – (to be elected by and from the financial members of the Administrative, Clerical & Customer Services Division, the number determined in accordance with WA Branch Rule 8)
- One (1) Branch Executive Councillor (ASU Municipal Employees) – (to be elected by and from the financial members of the ASU Municipal Employees Division, the number determined in accordance with WA Branch Rule 8)
- Three (3) Branch Executive Councillor (Energy / Information Technology) – (to be elected by and from the financial members of the Energy / Information Technology Division, the number determined in accordance with WA Branch Rule 8)
- Three (3) Branch Executive Councillor (Local Government) – (to be elected by and from the financial members of the Local Government Division, the number determined in accordance with WA Branch Rule 8)
- Two (2) Branch Executive Councillor (Social and Community Services) – (to be elected by and from the financial members of the Social and Community Services Division, the number determined in accordance with WA Branch Rule 8)
- One (1) Branch Executive Councillor (Transport) – (to be elected by and from the financial members of the Transport Division, the number determined in accordance with WA Branch Rule 8)

NATIONAL CONFERENCE DELEGATES (all four year terms)

- Six (6) National Conference Delegates (WA Branch) – (to be elected by and from the financial members of the WA Branch, the number determined by the number of AME's reported to National Office after 31st December 2010.

PROPORTIONAL REPRESENTATION


Division Five, Western Australian Branch Rule 19 – “Proportional Representation” requires that women shall be represented among Branch Executive Council members in accordance with the formula set out in sub-rule 19(a).

Sub-rule 19(b) requires the Branch Secretary to provide to the Returning Officer a certificate showing the percentage of women financial members in the WA Branch.

In the event that, at the declaration of the elections, the number of women elected as members of Branch Executive Council does not equal or exceed the number required, then the Returning Officer will be requested to commence a second election by immediately calling nominations for the number of officers being filled by women members and shall thereafter conduct the ballot.


