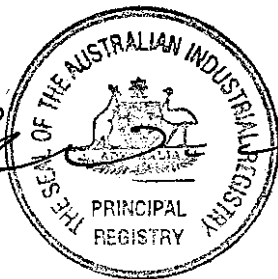
Arrangement for conduct of election.

Australian Nursing Federation (NSW Branch) Elections

This is to notify you that the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Nursing Federation is required under its rules to hold certain elections between 1 September and 30 October 2004.

The prescribed information required by s 189(1) of the RAO Schedule of the Australian Workplace Relations Act 1996 is as follows:

- (a) An election is required in the following offices:
 - Branch Secretary
 - Branch President
 - Branch Vice President
 - Branch Executive Member (four (4) to be elected)
 - Branch Councillor (sixteen (16) to be elected);
- (b) The reason for the election is that the term of office for all of these positions is due to expire on 29 November 2004;
- (c) In relation to the number of offices that have the same name, see (a) above;
- (d) The electorate comprises financial members of the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Nursing Federation;
- (e) In relation to the dates for the calling of nominations, the rules provide that the election is to be conducted between 1 September and 30 October, provided that the Returning Officer may call for nominations prior to 1 September;
- (f) The rules provide that the day on which the roll of voters is to close is the date of close of nominations for the election, and
- (g) The voting system to be used is a direct voting system.

Please note, that in relation to (f) above, the Rules of the Federation are currently in the process of being amended in order to comply with the provisions of subsection 143(3) [Day roll of voters closed] of the RAO Schedule.

I hereby state that I am the Secretary of the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Nursing Federation and am authorised to sign this statement that the above information is being lodged in accordance with s 189(1) of the RAO Schedule of the Act.

Accordingly I ask that you arrange for these elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission.
