Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 17 March 2015 the New South Wales Branch (the Branch) of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation (the organisation) lodged with the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) the prescribed information in relation to a casual vacancy election, for the remainder of the term, for the following office:

Branch Councillor (1)

[2] On 19 March 2015 the Commission contacted the Branch of the organisation to request a copy of a form of documentation to evidence the reason for the occurrence of the casual vacancy.

[3] On 20 March 2015 the Branch of the organisation lodged the requested documentation, which evidenced the cessation of membership of the former office holder.

[4] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed office is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

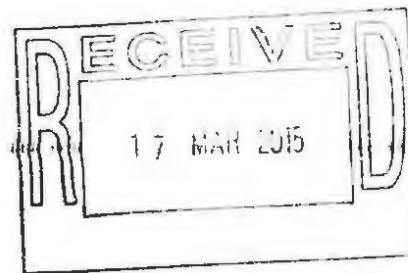

Re: Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation New South Wales Branch Council Vacancy

This is to notify you that the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation is required under its rules to hold a certain election as the result of a Councillor resigning her membership.

Dianne McKillop resigned her membership to the NSW Branch of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation in correspondence dated 12 February 2015. This resignation has now taken effect and as a result her position of Branch Councillor is now vacant.

In line with Rule 51.3, as the expired part of the term is less than 25% of the term of office an election is required, in accordance with the provisions of the Rules relating to election for the office in question.

The prescribed information required by section 189(1) of the RAO Schedule of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act) is as follows:

- a) An election is required for the office of Branch Councillor (one (1) to be elected);
- b) The reason for the election is that the position is vacant due to the resignation of membership;
- c) The electorate comprises financial members of the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation;
- d) In relation to the dates for the calling of nominations, this should occur as soon as practicable;

- e) The rules (Rule 85.4) provide that the roll of voters for an election is to be closed seven days before the day on which nominations are opened; and
- f) The voting system to be used is a direct voting system.
