I refer to the above election for your organisation.

Section 197(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Delegate of the General Manager, Fair Work Commission and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. A copy of the report in relation to this election is attached.

Section 198 of the Act requires that if an organisation or branch is given a post election report under section 197 that identifies a rule that was difficult to interpret or apply, the organisation or branch must, within 30 days, give a written response to the AEC on that aspect of the report. Further, Regulation 141(4) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 requires an organisation or branch to publish a notice on its web site advising members that a copy of the post election report is available upon request. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

This is to notify you that the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation (ANMF) is required under its rules to hold certain elections between 1 September and 30 October 2016.

The prescribed information required by section 189(1) of the RAO Schedule of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act) together as follows.

Please also note that minutes from a meeting of the Australian Nursing Federation New South Wales branch held at 43 Australia Street Camperdown NSW on 4 July 2006 at 6.37pm (excerpt of minutes attached) show a motion A50/2006 for the agreed break down of the positions as per information in (a) below.

- a) An election is required for the following offices:
- 1 (one) x Branch Secretary to be elected
  - 1 (one) x Branch Assistant Secretary to be elected
  - 1 (one) x Branch President to be elected
  - 1 (one) x Branch Vice President to be elected
  - 4 (four) x Branch Executive Members to be elected
  - 15 (fifteen) x Branch Councillors to be elected
- b) The reason for the election is that the term of office for these positions is due to expire in the normal course of events on 29 November 2016;
- c) The electorate comprises financial members of the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation;





- d) In relation to the dates for the calling of nominations, the rules provide that the election is to be conducted between 1 September 2016 and 30 October 2016, provided that the Returning Officer may call for nominations prior to 1 September 2016;
- e) The rules (Rule 85.4.1) provide that the roll of voters for an election is to be closed seven days before the day on which nominations are opened; and
- f) The voting system to be used is a direct voting system.
