Arrangement for conduct of election.

- [1] The attached document replaces the document previously issued with the above code on 25 July 2012.
- [2] The Branch has contacted Fair Work Australia requesting that a correcting decision be issued. The decision of 25 July 2012 identified the Branch as the "Queensland Branch" of the Australian Nursing Federation in accordance with wording that is used in rule 65A of the Standard Branch Rules. Rule 65A does not, however, reflect the name of the Branch as it appears in rule 59.1.2, which was altered on 3 July 2012 in matter number R2012/98 to "Australian Nursing Federation QNU Branch".
- [3] While there is an inconsistency between the name of the Branch as it appears in Rules 65A and 59.1.2, I am prepared to issue a correcting decision which identifies the name of the Branch as "Australian Nursing Federation QNU Branch".
- [4] On 6 July 2012 the Australian Nursing Federation QNU Branch lodged with Fair Work Australia the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:
