#### Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission ('the Commission') a declaration of results for the election E2017/45. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 154D(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each new holder of office with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that if applicable, the new holder of office undertakes approved training within the required timeframe and is advised of the obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, as provided for in your organisation's rules.

Section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation (or branch of an organisation) must notify the Commission of any changes to the records for the holders of office in the branch and regulation 151 prescribes a period of 35 days from the day after the change is made (e.g. the date of the AEC declaration) for such notification. This means, in this case, that the notification must be lodged by no later than 23 June 2017.

### Other Matters

The Roll of Voters was supplied with 19 addresses that had issues. These were either blank or two postal addresses for the voter. The RO had to request the organisation to supply a postal address for these voters.

There were 55,196 voters on the list of voters. A posting address was not provided for one member. The RO contacted the organisation but no mailing address was supplied to the RO. Therefore only 55,195 were sent in the original posting of the ballot.

Rule 49.2.8 Control a ballot box provided for the reception of the ballot papers and in the presence of the scrutineers, if they desire to be present, ensure that the box is empty immediately prior to the distribution of the ballot papers and thereupon seal such box and **ensure that it remains sealed until the time fixed for the closing of the ballot.** 

This delays the commencement of the markback process and therefore the scrutiny. Where the rules are silent on this issue, AEC policy allows for the markback to commence up to three (3) days prior to the closing of the ballot. This allows for the removal of the flaps that identify the voter and then the conduct of the scrutiny to commence shortly after the ballot closes.

Dear Delegate,

I am the Branch Secretary of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation QNU Branch ('the Branch').

In accordance with the rules of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation an election is required in relation to the offices of the Branch.

For the purposes of section 189(1) of *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act* and section 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations* 2009, the following information is the prescribed information for the Branch:

- (a) the name of each office for which an election is required:
  - (i) Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation QNU Branch Councillor; ('the Office').
- (b) the reason for the election is that a casual vacancy in the Office has occurred;

- (g) the kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is a direct voting system.
