In the course of examining the rules of the Branch I noted that the rules provide that a member may nominate for more than one office but cannot hold more than one office. In addition, the rules do not appear to provide for alternatives should a candidate be successful in a ballot for more than one office. The absence of such a rule may create a difficulty for the Returning Officer. This difficulty could be eliminated by the alteration of the Branch Rules to provide a 'hierarchy' of offices. In such circumstances the Returning Officer would be required to count votes in a particular order with the successful candidate being declared ineligible for the 'lesser' office.

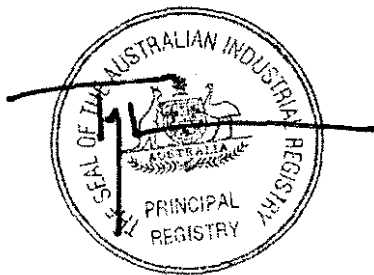

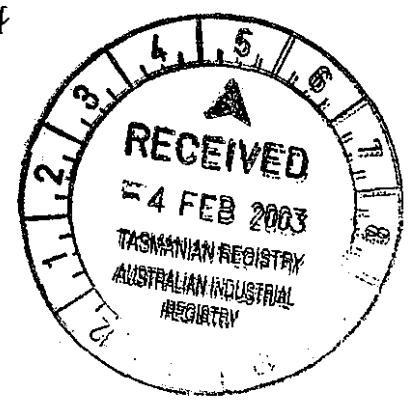

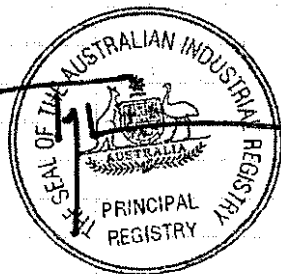
