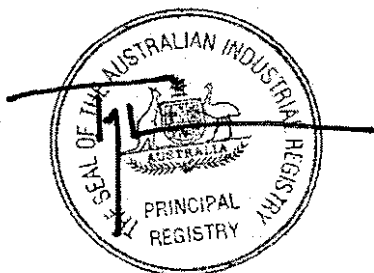
Arrangement for conduct of election.


Branch President (1 position)
