Arrangements for the conduct of an election (E2014/171)

I refer to the prescribed information dated 30 June 2014 which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission on 30 June 2014 for a scheduled election for the WA Branch of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation.

The prescribed information includes an election request for a Branch Secretary, however it appears the correct election request should be for a Branch President. In addition, the prescribed information includes an election request for two Branch Executive Committee Members; however rule 65.2.2 of the organisation's rulebook provides that the number of Branch Executive Committee Members should be four.

The prescribed information also includes an election request for nine Branch Councillors. Rule 65.2.3 of the organisation's rulebook provides that the number of Branch Councillors will be determined by each Branch Council as being between five and twenty. However no documentation was provided or any copy of a resolution which provides evidence that the number of Councillors to be elected was determined as being nine.

Could you provide the Fair Work Commission with a copy of a resolution or other documentation confirming that the number of Branch Councillors should indeed be nine as well as amended prescribed information for the offices of four Branch Executive Committee Members and one Branch President.
