Branch Councillors - Primary Sector (3), Secondary Sector (4)

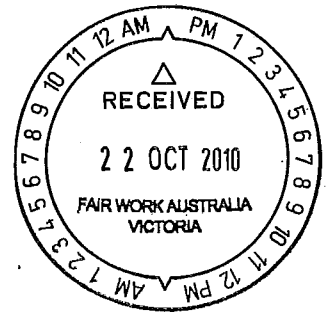

Pursuant to Regulation 138 Prescribed Information for election, Fair Work (registered Organisations) Regulations 2009, the following is provided:

(b) The reason for the election is that:

Consistent with Australian Principals' Federation Rule 47 (23) where the unexpired portion of a vacant term of office is greater than 12 months the vacancy shall be filled by election. Since the Term of Office for each of the above expires in Dec 2013 Rule 47 (23) (b) applies.
