

It has been brought to my attention that this Office made an error in identifying the number of delegates to Branch Council from the Fleet, Manufacture, Overhaul, Maintenance & Service Division

Rule 98 - Composition and Ordinary Meetings of the Branch Council states;

- (1) The Branch Council shall comprise the Branch President, the Senior Branch Vice-President, the Junior Branch Vice-President, the Branch Secretary, the Assistant Branch Secretary, the Presidents of each Branch Division, the Secretaries of each Branch Division, the Branch Organisers (where such positions are established as an Office under the Rules) and the Branch Divisional Organisers (where such positions are established as an Office under the Rules), one affirmative action (woman) from the Tram and Bus Division, one affirmative action (woman) from the Rail Divisions, one delegate from the Administrative, Supervisory, Technical and Professional Division in State Transit Authority and Sydney Ferries Corporation together with Delegates from Branch Divisions determined in accordance with Sub-Rule 98 (2).
- (2) For the purpose of electing Delegates to the Branch Council, each Branch Division, other than the Tram & Bus Division, shall be divided into Districts as provided for in Sub-Clause 98 (3). The Branch Tram & Bus Division and each Branch Divisional District as specified in Sub-Clause 98 (3) shall, subject to Sub-Clause 98 (4), be entitled to one Delegate for each eight hundred members or part thereof. The number of Delegates to which the Branch Tram & Bus Division or a Branch Divisional District is entitled, shall be determined on the basis of the number of financial members within the Branch Division or the Branch Divisional District, as the case may be, at the end of the quarter immediately preceding the date for the opening of nominations for the election of Delegates.

Dear Greg,

I am sending this email so you have it for Monday morning. I will not be at my desk during the day for Monday and Tuesday, as I have to attend a course, but please feel free to reply by email when it is convenient to you as I will pick up messages when I check things in the evening. I will be fully back on deck on Wednesday.

Thank you for sending me the Divisional membership break-up figures for NSW, WA and TAS. Of course I realise that I will need to check the number of Branch Divisional Delegates to National Council for QLD, VIC and SA/NT also – so I apologise for not asking for them before, but could you email the QLD, VIC and SA/NT Divisional membership figures as well?

Secondly, I have examined the figures for WA and TAS against the prescribed information ("PI") you lodged, and they correspond, so that is fine.

Where the NSW Branch is concerned I have identified the following position numbers and descriptions for amendment:

- 1. The number of Divisional Delegates to National Council from the Branch Locomotive Division requested in the PI was 3, but the membership totalled 3020, so by rule 28(3) one rep for every 1000 or part thereof I make this 4. Do you agree?
- The number of Sub-Divisional Representatives to Branch Locomotive Divisional Council requested for ETR Region 3 was 1, but the membership total given on the second page was 616 (and on the third page 610), so, whichever is correct, by rule 100(4) – one rep for every 500 or part thereof – I make this 2; do you agree?
- 3. The number of Sub-Divisional Representatives to Branch Locomotive Divisional Council requested for Pacific National Group North West Region was 1, but the membership total given on the second page was 507 (and on the third page 506), so, whichever is correct, by rule 100(4) again I make this 2; do you agree?
- 4. The names of some of the sub-divisional groups and numbers of Depot organiser representatives requested for the Locomotive Sub-Divisions on pages 10 and 11 of the PI did not exactly correspond with the names of the groups listed on pages 7, 8 and 9 of the PI or with the names listed on the membership figures attachment.

I have presumed that some of the names on the PI reflect how they were described and organised at the time of the last election and that the names on the membership figures attachment (which corresponds closely to the names on pages 7,8 and 9) would be the most up-to-date descriptions and organisation of the companies/geographic areas, so I have set out these names in the draft Registrar's decision. Accordingly, I have identified a couple of extra representative requirements. The first is from Mt Victoria, within the Intercity Group, whose membership is 21, and by rule 100(4) this depot/area seems entitled to one depot organiser. The second is possibly from Moss Vale, again within the Intercity Group, whose membership is 20.

Now the relevant sentence in rule 100(4) is expressed a little unfortunately in that it requires a depot organiser for workplaces with "greater than 20 members" and a work organiser for workplaces with "less than 20 members" – there is no provision for workplaces with exactly 20 members! I have tentatively included a representative in the draft decision on the presumption that it is more usual for people to say "20 or more" than "20 or less", but I leave the interpretation to the Union and it can be omitted if that is how the rule was meant.

 Finally, on page 6 of the PI, one (1) representative is requested for the Fleet, maintenance etc, Divisional Committee for "Southern & Western Districts Group Combined". This seems to me to be an error. The relevant paragraph in rule 100(4) is:

Each Group within the Branch Fleet Manufacture, Overhaul, Maintenance and Service Division shall be entitled to a Representative or Representatives on the Branch Divisional Committee as set out in the following schedule:

Metropolitan District Group - 4 Representatives (including One Bus Engineering Representative) Northern District Group - 1 Representative Western District Group - 1 Representative Southern District Group - 1 Representative

It is only for electing Divisional Delegates to Branch Council that, pursuant to rule 98(3), the Fleet District Groups are partially combined. Consequently I have set out in the draft decision, a separate representative for each of the Fleet Western and Southern District Groups.

All the changes to position numbers I have referred to above can be identified by looking at the draft decision list which I attach to this email. The changes are all in bold pink type. Also in bold pink type are the couple of Locomotive Divisional Group name updates, and Depot/Geographical area name updates [e.g. "Broadmeadow" rather than "Kooragang (Broadmeadow)", and "Southern Highlands" rather than "Southern Highlands (Moss Vale)"] – to correspond with how they are described in the membership attachment.

Please indicate whether you agree or not with these suggested changes. If you agree, it will probably be better to lodge a letter that formally "amends" the previous PI in respect of the details altered. However, in case one of the QLD, VIC or SA/NT numbers also needs amendment, perhaps it would be better to delay lodging such a letter until after I have had a chance to check them too.

I will endeavour to get the completed final decision ready for issuing as a priority for the Union.


