The corresponding obligations set out in the RAO Schedule apply to each financial year of an organisation that starts on or after 1 July 2003.

Please note that a branch of an organisation may be exempted from the accounting, auditing and reporting obligations in respect of a financial year by satisfying a Registrar that the branch did not have any financial affairs during the financial year. An application under subsection 271A(1) of the Act must be made within 90 days (unless extended by a Registrar) after the end of the financial year.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2003

1. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles using the accruals basis of accounting.

Australian Accounting Standards and Statement of Accounting Concepts as issued by the joint professional accounting bodies, have been adopted where appropriate.
