Rang Victorian Branch to ascertain why committee positions were being requested as declaration of results on 19/12/2002 showed all 7 positions filled in last election E2002/136. Spoke with Trevor Dobbyn. During the discussion it became apparent to us both that two of the Committee positions declared elected were in the names of Brian Gamble and Tony Brock, who were both elected and held office on the Sub-Divisional Committee on a separate basis, namely being Secretary and Vice President respectively. This meant the declaration of results had inadvertently confirmed only 5 of the 7 Committee positions.

Rang Michael Pryor of the AEC. Outlined problem. He agreed that the declaration appeared to have incorporated a mistake but confirmed that the only way the positions could be filled now would be by a new election.
