### Re: Arrangements for the conduct of an Election (E2008/118)

I write in relation to your request for an election to fill casual vacancies pursuant to subsection 189(1) of the RAO Schedule, which was lodged in the Registry on 8 February 2008. I apologise for the delay in providing my response.
