Prescribed Information

Election in Australian Retailers Association Election of Members of the ARA Council for 2009/2010

(a) Name of each office for which election is required:

- ARA President
- ARA Vice Presidents (2)
- ARA Secretary
- ARA Treasurer

- 4 members representing retail businesses in Victoria, with at least 2 being a National Retailer (Rule 21.1 (b)) ;
- 4 members representing retail business in New South Wales with at least 2 being a National Retailer.
- 1 member representing retail businesses in Queensland;
- 1 member representing retail businesses in South Australia;
- 1 member representing retail businesses in Western Australia;
- 1 member representing retail businesses in Tasmania.

Note: the expression “National Retailer” and “State Retailer” is defined in Rule 5 of the Rules of the Australian Retailers Association (“ARA”).

(b) Reasons for election:

Bi-Annual Elections are required in all divisions in accordance with Rule 21.1.

(c) The number of offices to be filled:

Eleven (11)

(d) Date and time of commencement and expiration of period for calling of nominations:

Within three (3) days after the declaration of the election of the ARA Council, and not more than seven (7) days before the closing of nominations – Refer rule 39.4 (b) (ii) of the ARA rules.

(e) The day provided in the Rules of the Organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to close:

14 days prior to the day upon which nominations for the election are to open see Rule 39.3 and Rule 39.4 (b) (i) for the ARA Rules.

(f) Method of election

Collegiate voting system – see Rule 39.1(e)

Secret postal ballot – see Rules 39.3, 39.4 and 39.5

The information referred to in this statement is lodged in accordance with Section 189 (1) of Schedule 1 of the Act.
