

On 15 January 1996, the abovenamed organisation lodged in the Industrial Registry prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

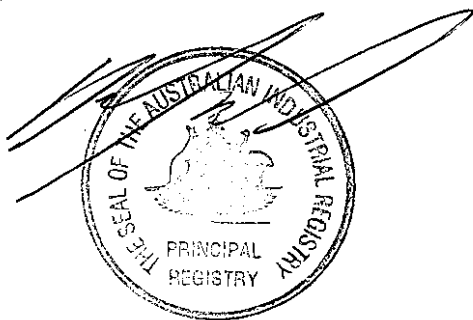

(b) The reason for the election is that the term of office of all positions have expired.


(c) The electorate for all offices listed in (a) above, with the exception of Secretary/Treasurer, comprises only members of the Council of A.R.T.I.O.
