- 9 The electorates of the respective branch committee members (6) required to be elected by direct voting system comprise all members of the respective branch, subject to the financial status of such members giving them the right to vote.

- 11 In the circumstances of the elections for the offices the subject of this notification, it is submitted that the direct election for the offices referred to in paragraph 15 below must be completed as the first stage. Accordingly, for Branch Committee Members (6):

- 12 Dates for the opening and closing of nominations of all other offices are dependent upon whether a ballot or ballots are necessary, having regard to the minimum time periods for nominating under the rules, as set out in the following paragraphs 13 to 17.

Offices of the organisation

- 13 In respect of the election by direct voting system for the Secretary/Treasurer, the nominations are required to remain open for not less than 10 and not more than 20 days (subrule 30(4)).
