The documents were received in this office on 6 December 2002.

While the documents have been filed, the following matters are drawn to your attention to assist in the preparation of financial documents for year ending 30 June 2003.

1. Accounting Officers Certificate, Committee of Management Certificate and Auditor's Report

The auditor in his report is required to give an opinion in respect of accounts and statements prepared in accordance with section 273 of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*; such accounts include the certificates of the accounting officer and the committee of management. The dates of the certificates supplied would indicate preparation after the auditor made his report. Would you please bring this matter to your auditor's attention.

2. Auditor's Report

• The signatory to the auditor's report for financial years ended 30 June 1995 -

30 June 2000 inclusive has not indicated whether he/she is registered as a company auditor - refer regulation 112 of the *Workplace Relations Regulations 1996* (available on our website at www.airc.gov.au). It is the attitude of this Office that this fact should be evident to members in the published financial documents.

• The auditor's report for financial year ended 30 June 2002 refers to the Industrial Organization Act 1997. The documents should not only reflect the appropriate provisions of, but also be audited pursuant to, the appropriate legislation, currently the federal Workplace Relations Act 1996.

Both of these matters should also be drawn to the auditor's attention.

3. Prescribed information notice

There should be included in the accounts a notice drawing attention to provisions of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 that prescribed information is available to members on request and which sets out a copy of subsections 274(1), (2) and (3) - refer subsection (4) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996. This requirement was omitted from the financial documents for years ended 30 June 1998 - 30 June 2002 inclusive.

4. Legislative timescale provisions

I have noted that the financial statements of the branch for financial years ending 30 June 1995 - 2001 inclusive were lodged outside the time scales prescribed by the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*. I have enclosed for your information a copy of those time scale provisions. You will note that there is a requirement to prepare accounts and statements (including certificates in relation to the accounts by the accounting officer and the committee of management) as soon as practicable after the end of the financial year. Please ensure that financial statements for year ending 30 June 2003 are lodged within the abovementioned time scale provisions.



NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE, 2002

1. ACCOUNTING METHODS

The accounts are prepared on the cash basis. The reason for using this method in lieu of the accrual basis of accounting is that the volume of transactions does not warrant the introduction of accrual accounting and the additional costs involved.

Otherwise, the accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards.

In Particular:-

- (a) The accounts have not been adjusted to record either changes in the general purchasing power of the dollar or in the price of specific assets.
- (b) No liability exists for income tax as the organization is exempt from income tax under Section 51-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act, 1997.

AUDITORS REPORT INDUSTRIAL ORGANISATIONS ACT 1997, SECTION 204 (2)

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* ('the Act') for the financial year ended 30 June, 2002.

The legislative scheme set out in Part IX, Division 11 of the Act is directed at ensuring that a registered organisation or a branch of such an organisation discharges obligations of accountability to its members in relation to its financial affairs through proper and regular disclosure of financial information. The various steps of the financial reporting requirements must be carried out within the time-scales prescribed by the legislation so as to ensure the relevance of the financial information provided to the members.

Now that the financial year has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.
