Do solemnly declare

The following information is provided in the terms of regulation 61 of the workplace relations Act 1996.

- Rule 19 of the Constitution and Rules provides for a Branch Committee of not less than 5 and not more than 10. Rule 22 provides for the election of a president, two (2) Vice Presidents, a Secretary/Treasurer and two (2) Committee Members to form the Committee of Management
- The reason for the necessity of an election is that the Terms of Office of the previous Office Holders has expired,
- The correct title of the Branch is the Australian Road Transport Industrial Organisation Western Australian Branch.
- 4. Rule 22 (3) requires that within seven (7) days after the Annual General Meeting of the Branch, the returning Officer to the Branch appointed for the purpose shall deliver or forward to each members of the Branch Committee a notification that nominations are required for the offices described in Rule 22 (1) which shall state the hour and date on which nominations shall close 9which shall be not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) from the date of delivery of such notification) and the address to which nominations shall be forwarded.
 - Election of the Branch Committee (Rule 19) shall occur by the forwarding of a notice to all members calling for nominations at least 30 days and not more than 60 days before the Annual General Meeting.
- Voting for the Branch Committee (Rule 19) shall be by Secret Postal Ballot. Voting for the Officers described in Rule 22(1) shall be by Secret Postal Ballot.

And I make this solemn declaration by virtue of the Statutory Declaration Act 1959, and subject to the penalties proved by that Act for the making false statements in statutory declarations, conscientiously believing the statements contained in this declaration to be true in every particular.
