- (c) Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required has the same name and the number of such can, in accordance with the rules of the organisation or branch, be ascertained before the prescribed day – the number of those offices:

Is identified in Annexure A to this application.

- (d) Where the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation – the name of that branch, section or division, as the case may be:

- Branch Councils as identified in Annexure A to this application;
- Federal Council;
- Federal Executive.

- (e) The date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules of the organisation or branch in relation to the election:

Subject to any variation by the Industrial Registrar:

- **Branch Councils** – 14 February and 28 February 2006. (Rule 64 of the ASMOF Rules)
- **Federal Council** – the commencement date for nomination as a delegate to Federal Council is seven days after the declaration of the poll for offices on branch council. The expiration of the nomination period will be on a date specified by the branch returning officer. (Rule 65 of the ASMOF Rules)
- **Federal Executive** – the commencement and closing dates for nominations will be determined by reference to the Rule 66(1)(a) of the ASMOF Rules:

(a) *Within seven (7) days after the declaration of the poll in relation to the election of delegates to the Federal Council, the Branch Secretary of each Branch shall advise the Federal Secretary in writing of the names and postal addresses of the elected delegates of such branch. Within fourteen days*

(14) days after the Federal Secretary has received the names and postal addresses of all the elected delegates, the Federal Returning Officer shall send by prepaid post to each of the elected delegates a list of the names and postal addresses of all the elected delegates and shall invite each of them to nominate in writing for any one or more of the offices of the Federation and shall specify a closing date before which the nomination must reach the Federal Returning Officer. A nomination need be signed only by the person nominating."

In circumstances where, at the closing date of nominations, it appears that any branch does not have a representative on Federal Council, the Federal Returning Officer will forthwith call nominations and presumably, at the that time, determine a closing date for nominations. (Rule 66(2) of the ASMOF Rules)

(f) The day provided for in the rules of the organization as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed


The roll of voters is to be closed on the seventh day before the day on which nominations for the election open.

(g) The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election:

- **Branch Councils** – a direct, preferential voting system where a branch's members elect its branch council. (Rule 64 of the ASMOF Rules);
- **Federal Council** – a collegiate system, where members of a branch council elect the branch delegates to Federal Council. (Rule 65 of the ASMOF Rules)
- **Federal Executive** – a collegiate system where members of Federal Council elect the Federal Executive. (Rule 66 of the ASMOF Rules)

The information contained in this application and Annexure A to this application is lodged in accordance with subsection 189(1) of Schedule 1 - Registration and Accountability of Organisations of the *Workplace Relations Act (1996)*. I am authorised by the ASMOF rules to make this statement.
