Financial Reporting Obligations under Workplace Relations Act 1996

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the Workplace Relations Act 1996 ('the Act') for the financial year ended 31 December, 2001.

The legislative scheme set out in Part IX, Division 11 of the Act is directed at ensuring that a registered organisation or a branch of such an organisation discharges obligations of accountability to its members in relation to its financial affairs through proper and regular disclosure of financial information. The various steps of the financial reporting requirements must be carried out within the time-scales prescribed by the legislation so as to ensure the relevance of the financial information provided to the members.

In relation to financial documents for year ended 31 December 2001, the auditor should have made a report to the branch as required by subsection 276(1) of the Act before 30 June 2002. If you have not done so already you should consider implementing the following steps:

- provision of copies of the auditor's report, accounts and statements to the members,
- following provision of copies to the members, presentation of the auditor's report, accounts and statements to a meeting of the members or the committee of management
- lodgement of copies of the auditor's report, accounts and statements in the Industrial Registry
 accompanied by your certificate confirming that the documents so lodged are copies of those
 presented to the relevant meeting the certificate should specify the type of meeting and the date
 when the meeting was held.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2001

NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report is a general purpose financial report that has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views, other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board and the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The financial report covers the Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation Queensland Branch as an individual entity. The Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation Queensland Branch is a Trade Union incorporated under the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The accounts have been prepared on a cash basis and in accordance with the historical costs convention and do not reflect changes in either the general purchasing power of the dollar, or except where otherwise stated, in the value of non-current assets.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Union in the preparation of the accounts.

a) Income tax

No provision for income tax has been raised as the Union operates solely as a trade union under the Workplace Relations Act 1996 and accordingly is exempt from income tax under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

b) Interest rate risk and credit risk exposures

The union manages its exposure to interest rate through regular discussions with the Commonwealth Bank and does not engage in significant transactions, which are speculative in nature.

The maximum credit risk exposure of the financial assets is represented by the carrying amounts of assets recognised in the Statement of Financial Position, net of any provisions for losses.

The Union does not have any significant concentration of credit risk.

c) Comparative figures

Where necessary, comparative figures have been adjusted to conform with the financial report's disclosures adopted this year.

NOTE 2: INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, as amended, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of subsections 274 as follows:

- A member of an organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation;

To the Members of the Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation, Queensland Branch (the Union),

Scope

We have audited the Financial Report of the Union, for the year ended 31 December 2001 as set out on pages 1 to 5. The members of the Board are responsible for the Financial Report. We have conducted an independent audit of the Financial Report in order to express an opinion on them to the members of the Union.

Our audit was conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance whether the Financial Report is free of material misstatement. Our procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the Financial Report, and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. Matters requiring attention when preparing future financial returns

The following matters concerning the financial reporting requirements of the Act is advised for your assistance when preparing financial returns:

No further action is required in respect of the subject documents. However, it would be appreciated if the same matter is not repeated for the next financial year.

Timescale provisions

Timing of steps at variance with legislation

Financial documents should be prepared, audited, supplied to members, presented to a meeting and lodged with the Registrar within certain timescale requirements - these requirements are summarised for your assistance in the attachment.

From the information available, the timing of these various steps would seem to be at variance with the requirements of the legislation.

Insufficient time before documents presented to meeting

Given that the auditor's report, accounting officer's and committee of management certificates are all dated 4 September 2002, it would appear that the committee of management meeting held on that date was not sufficient for the purposes of section 279(6). The meeting may have been sufficient for the purposes of regulation 109(2)(a).

The relevant timescale requirements of the Act are summarised for your assistance in the attachment.

Documents supplied to members before auditor's report

The auditor's report is dated 4 September 2002 whereas your Secretary's Certificate of 4 September 2002 indicates that the documents were made available free of charge on the ASMOFQ website from July 2002. It appears therefore, that the documents were supplied to the members before the making of the auditor's report refer subsection 279(3) of the Act.
