Re: Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation-Victoria Branch Financial Reporting Obligations under Workplace Relations Act 1996

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* ('the Act') for the financial year ended 31 December, 2001.

The legislative scheme set out in Part IX, Division 11 of the Act is directed at ensuring that a registered organisation or a branch of such an organisation discharges obligations of accountability to its members in relation to its financial affairs through proper and regular disclosure of financial information. The various steps of the financial reporting requirements must be carried out within the time-scales prescribed by the legislation so as to ensure the relevance of the financial information provided to the members.

In relation to financial documents for year ended 31 December 2001, the auditor should have made a report to the branch as required by subsection 276(1) of the Act before 30 June 2002. If you have not done so already you should consider implementing the following steps:

- provision of copies of the auditor's report, accounts and statements to the members,
- following provision of copies to the members, presentation of the auditor's report, accounts and statements to a meeting of the members or the committee of management
- lodgement of copies of the auditor's report, accounts and statements in the Industrial Registry
  accompanied by your certificate confirming that the documents so lodged are copies of those
  presented to the relevant meeting the certificate should specify the type of meeting and the date
  when the meeting was held.

Please do not hesitate to contact me on (03) 8661 7787 if you wish to discuss the financial reporting requirements, especially if you anticipate any difficulty in meeting any step in the time-scales prescribed.

## NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31<sup>ST</sup> DECEMBER 2001

### (i). Statement of significant accounting policies.

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared for use by the Branch Council. The Branch Council has determined that the organisation is not a reporting entity. No Australian Accounting Standards or mandatory professional reporting requirements or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been used in the preparation of this financial report.

The financial report is prepared on a cash basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values, or except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The organisation, as a registered Trade Union, is exempt from income tax and no provision for income tax is necessary.

### (ii). Information to be provided to members or registrar

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, as amended, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-Section (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274, which read as follows:

- (1) A member of an organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.
- (2) An organisation shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a member of the organisation or a Registrar make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

I have received the financial documents of the Victorian Branch of the Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation for the year ended 31 December 2001 which were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 11 November 2002.

The following matters are referred for assistance when preparing future financial returns; no further action is required in respect of these documents.

## 1. Accounting Officer's Certificate

It is noted that the accounting officer's certificate is undated.

All certificates should be dated as a matter of course.

## 2. Committee of Management's Certificate

The committee of management's certificate has been signed after the making of the auditor's report to the Branch. This certificate should not post-date the auditor's report as:

- the auditor must express an opinion on the accounts and statements prepared under section 273 of the Act refer section 274(4)(a)(ii); and
- the accounts prepared under section 273 must include certificates by the accounting officer and the committee of management refer Regulation 109(1).

## 3. Timescale provisions

Financial documents should be prepared, audited, supplied to members, presented to a meeting and lodged with the Registrar within certain timescale requirements - these requirements are summarised for your assistance in the attachment.

From the information available, the timing of these various steps would seem to be at variance with the requirements of the legislation:

- the documents were not supplied to members within 56 days of the auditor's report; and
- the documents were not lodged in the Industrial Registry within 14 days of the second meeting.

The documents have been filed.
