There appears to be a lapse in time between receiving membership payment for subscriptions and when the Association updates the member's records. At the close of the roll and the close of nominations this lead to members being incorrectly identified as having status of 'unfinancial'.

The Association does not appear to comply with the Rules in transferring members between membership types, eg from Associate to Corporate. Transfers are required to be endorsed by the Committee of Management before they are effected.

Reasons for election:

Election for offices and positions outlined above is required as the terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

Elected by:

The electorate for the direct voting system is the whole of the National organisation.

Nominations open:

For offices to be elected by direct voting system - the 2nd day of August 2010.

Nominations close:

For offices to be elected by direct voting system - 12 noon, on the twenty-first (21st) day after nominations have opened being 23rd day of August 2010.

Cut off date for roll:

In all cases – thirty (30) days prior to the opening date for nominations being the 2nd day of July 2010 - rule 16.10.6.

Notes:

The Notice and Statement are required to be lodged at least 2 months before the first day of nominations as set out in the rules of the organisation – the General Manager of FWA may allow for a later day - see subsection 189(2) and regulations.

The requirement to lodge election information under s189(2) is a civil penalty provision - see s305.
