Branch Elections - E2004/318

I refer to your letter of 2 February 2005 concerning the decision in this matter as it affects the Branch.

I note that you consider the decision which determines that the rules require two "Branch Executive Committee Members" to be elected by members of each of the New South Wales and Victorian Sub-branches may misconstrue the rules. You consider that as the decision also provides for the election of the offices of Branch Secretary, President, Vice-President, the total number of offices on the Branch Executive Committee would be seven not five.

You propose that instead the decision should provide only for the election of "Two Branch Committee Members" among the other officers of the Branch. This however, would not provide for the election by members of the Sub-Branches of the four persons to the Branch Electoral College, two of whom will become or occupy (after the conduct of the election for the offices of Branch President and Branch Vice-President by the college provided for in the rules) the offices of Branch Executive Committee members.

The format of the decision and the description of the offices to be elected in the Branch are consistent with the decision of the Deputy Industrial Registrar in E2001/20. I note that according to the declaration of the Returning Officer for the Branch in that election, that nominations were called for the positions as described in the decision and that following the collegiate election, two of the four persons elected by the Sub-Branches were elected to the offices of President and Vice-President and the remaining two became the Branch Executive Committee Members. This result would appear to reflect the requirements of the rules.

In these circumstances, I do not propose to amend my decision.

If the Branch or the Union remains of the view that the rules are being misconstrued, it is open to the organisation to alter them to better reflect its intentions.

E2004/318 - Prescribed Information

I refer to the prescribed information lodged on 23 December 2004 and amending information lodged on 7 and 13 January 2005 and to my discussions with Mr Paul Howes of your office.

Subject to the Industrial Registrar's certification of the alterations to the Union's rules in matter R2005/101 lodged on 11 January 2005, which would then provide for a third office of Vice President in the Queensland Branch, there appears to be only one further issue on which the Union's comments are sought.

Tobacco Workers Branch

Sub-rule 33(7)(w) provides for a "Branch Executive" comprising the offices specified. The prescribed information includes each office of the Executive except for the "Two Branch Executive Committee Members (honorary)".

As the prescribed information identifies, the holders of the offices of President and Vice-President are elected by the Branch Executive College described in the sub-rule as follows:

The New South Wales Sub-Branch and the Victorian Sub-Branch must respectively elect pursuant to RULE 63 METHOD OF BALLOTING – DIRECT ELECTORAL SYSTEM, two persons from each Sub-Branch who, together with the Branch Secretary will comprise the Branch Executive College.

The rules then provide for the members of the Branch Executive College to elect two of their number to the offices of Branch President and Branch Vice-President - these offices are referred to in the prescribed information. The two remaining members of the College (not being the President, Vice-President or Branch Secretary) "become the Branch Executive Committee Members" - these offices do not appear in the prescribed information.

It would therefore appear that in addition to the offices referred to in the prescribed information, the rules require that elections be conducted for the offices of "Two Branch Executive Committee Members (honorary)" and that these offices should be included in the prescribed information.

I note that these two offices of the Branch Executive were included in the decision of Deputy Industrial Registrar Buchanan in matter E2001/20 who, after considering the different election stages provided for within the Branch considered it appropriate to set out in her decision of 9 March 2001 all the Branch offices requiring an election.
