DECISION



1. National Office

1.1 Six National Vice Presidents (Honorary)

Reasons for election:

Election for all offices and positions above are required as the terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the union.

Elected by:

The positions are elected by direct voting system, the electorate is the entire union.

Nominations open:

For offices to be elected by direct voting system - the last Wednesday of February 2005.

For offices to be elected by collegiate election – pursuant to Rule (64) at the first Branch Executive meeting following the elections held pursuant to Rule (61).

Nominations close:

For offices to be elected by direct voting system - 12 noon, 9 March 2005.

Cut off date for roll:

Subject to the requirements of Rule (63 (1)) 31 March 2005.
